1. Conferment of Legal Title

1.1. The Author confers upon the Publisher, in respect of all editions and publications of the work entitled

Topological Methods in the Quest for Periodic Orbits

in the Series/Collection

EMS Series of Lectures in Mathematics

(hereinafter referred to as "the Work")

the exclusive rights of reproduction by means of printing, reprinting or any other method deemed appropriate by the Publisher including electronic means, and of distribution of the Work, as well as the exclusive rights of translation into all languages and for all countries. The Publisher agrees, in its own name or that of the Author, to protect these rights against third parties and to cause the copyright symbol to appear in all publications of the Work in accordance with the provisions of the International Copyright Agreement.

1.2. The Author declares that he is the sole owner of the copyright, that he has not transferred his rights respecting the Work to any third party and that the Work does not infringe upon the rights of third parties. In the event that the Author himself does not have full rights to the illustrations, he is required to obtain permission to use these from the copyright holder. The Author is obliged to supply full details of all sources of information employed by him.

1.3. The Author agrees that he may not enter into an agreement with any other publisher to produce a book of similar content and scope.

2. Delivery of Manuscript/Content
