To support part time or full time summer study for a Stony Brook Mathematics undergraduate student, providing critical early-career assistance to help the student advance his/her knowledge and skills.

The Summer Math Scholarship will provide support for tuition, housing, food, and fees for up to 12 credits, and is open to rising Stony Brook University juniors or seniors with a minimum 3.2 GPA in mathematics coursework interested in taking independent math study. Out of state and foreign Stony Brook University students are eligible to apply but tuition reimbursement is at the in-state rate.

Scholarship Application Deadline: Applications must be postmarked no later than February 23, 2018.
